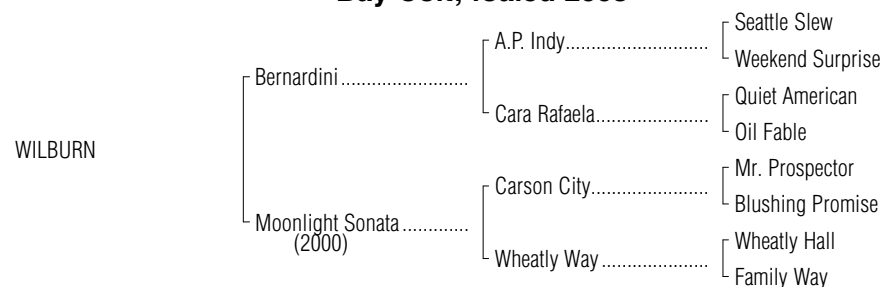

[G1] (SAR, \$600,000), etc.), Biondetti (\$346,391, Gran Criterium [G1], etc.), A Z Warrior (\$286,906, Frizette S. [G1] (BEL, \$180,000), etc.), To Honor and Serve [G2] (\$996,340), Wilburn [G2].
